Vice Chair Update – presented by Ann Bone

Pantry Bed and Harvest Team Update

- The best January to date with a 120 pounds of food recorded.
- Marcy Dunn has stepped down in her position as bed tender.  
Help wanted to fill this position will be posted in the upcoming newsletter due out this month.

Membership Update – presented by Cyndi McGill

- Twenty-eight individuals on the current wait list.
- We have received 3 resignations from garden members (plots # 512, 514 and 516).
- New plots: Daniel and Monique Bradberry plot #300 and Marilyn and Bill Anchors plot # 312
- Current open beds- #304, #409 and #416

### Greenhouse Update – presented by Art Simon

- Plant Sale preparation is under way and progressing well.
- Warm weather vegetables will be started late February to early March.
- Compost is temporarily unavailable due to an issue with Dekalb County facility. Art will look for new vendors to fill the void.
- Jeff Leech related there is plenty of compost available in the garden area and perhaps arrangements could be made with Gabe Neps to transport between the garden and greenhouse.

### Main Garden Update – presented by Jeff Leech

- Total of 9 beds have been rebuilt. Cyndi McGill will forward a memo to all plot owners that the repairs have been completed.
- Edging completed in the kiwi beds.
- Tomato cages to be relocated to the back fence.
- Locks have been replaced. Codes remain 1776 for the garden and 1965 for the shed.

### Social Director Recap – presented by Sheila Wilder

- With mask mandate requirements, refreshments will be reconsidered for the March MG Talk .

### Community Outreach and Communication

- Publicity is currently up to date for the Master Gardener session to the usual outlets: Aha, Patch, Master Gardeners, Dunwoody News, newsletter to members and DCGO website.
