- Deadline for planting warm season crops is July 20th, members will be provided with a list of suitable vegetables
- Mexican bean beetles continue to run rampant in the garden. Neem oil and new containers will be provided for member use in the garden shed

- Apples are ready and will be harvested in the morning
- Richard is preparing to order seeds and is requesting members to provide their list for pantry beds and fall plant sale

Main Garden Update – Jeff Leech

- Mission youth group volunteer workday is scheduled for Thursday, July 20th. MS & HS students will be paired with MG who will act as project leads for the day
- Groups of 4 volunteers/task
- Garden Projects will include:

Weeding orchard and muscadines, 9 plots need attention including weeding, reset plastic crop rings, crushed stone to be spread in the gravel parking lot, and weed eating the garden perimeter

- Greenhouse projects will include:
- Mulching shade garden path, rebuilding the ADA bed, and washing terra cotta pots
- Sheila will purchase and provide water and refreshments for the volunteers

- Waivers has been provided and are required to be completed prior to workday
- Jeff will obtain estimates on replacing the current irrigation system and report back at the August meeting
