- Harvest Total: 162.9 pounds of produce. Mini harvest scheduled for tomorrow in the greenhouse.
- Greens and peppers harvested today.

### **Treasurer's Report**

- Financial reports distributed to committee members. DCGO remains financially secure.
- Sun shed projected cost \$2,500 which should be self funded with donations. Possibility of demolishing current shed. Cyndi will return with Russ to reassess. Richard and Jeff agreed to attend.

- **Status:** summer crops are finished. 80% of the greenhouse has transitioned to fall crops. Tender vegetables covered.
- Propane tank refill

  - Lettuce, kale, and peppers harvested. Sweet potato harvest was minimal.
  - Bok choy will be available in 1-2 weeks
- **Furniture:** bench has been painted. Remainder of furniture will be painted when the temperature warms up. Pergola furniture will be added, projected cost \$300.

- Fence Rebuild:

- **Bed Rebuild:** Jeff thanked all the members that helped to rebuild a total of 10 beds.
- MLK of Service: Members to start thinking about projects that need to be completed on the workday.

- **Cob Bench:** Continues to deteriorate. No reply from family members on where to send artifacts.
- Addition of a dog area: Dogs in the garden becoming an issue. Possibility of adding an area by the swing in the garden for dogs. Pros and cons discussed.

**Pro**: dogs would be contained in a controlled area. City currently cleans the dog park monthly, possibility of asking for assistance in cleaning this site as well.

**Cons:** Potential for fighting if numerous dogs were corralled in the area at same time, urine odor, who would be responsible for cleaning the area, disposal of excrement, addition of waste station.

**Decision:** Article will be added in the newsletter explaining why dogs are restricted from the garden. Addition of no dog allowed signs on all gates.
